#### **Indicators**







#### Geography

The socio-economic catchment profile is based on two distinct geographies. Firstly, the official settlement boundary for the town (based on Central Statistics Office definition) and secondly, a drive-time isochrone or travel catchment to each settlement. Two isochrones are represented here a 0-30 minute travel isochrone and a one-hour travel isochrone (see green and blue areas below).



Within a one hour drivetime there is a total working age opulation of 254,726. This figure represents approximately 5.99 of the All-Island working age population (4.317M) in 2016.




















Within a 60 minute drivetime a population of 29,995 are non-native anguage speakers. This can be broken down into Polish 5,843 (19.5% French 2,440 (8.1%), Lithuanian 5,706 (19%) and Other 16,006 (53.4%




























## **Employment and Commuting Flows Resident Workers and Locally based Jobs**






#### Where are Cootehill resident workers (1,062) employed?

#### Cootehill based Jobs - where do workers come from? (1,402)











There are 1,062 people residing in the Cootehill settlement area who are classed as being 'At Work'. Of these workers, a total of 41% (432) are employed in Cootehill, 19% (207) are employed elsewhere in Cavan, 25% (261) commute out of the county for employment and the remaining 15% (162) are either Mobile workers or have a blank or un-codeable destination.



In total, there are 1,402 jobs located within the Cootehill settlement. Of these, 31% (432) are undertaken by local residents living in Cootehill, 40% (557) are undertaken by workers living elsewhere in Cavan county (see Map on following page) and the remaining 27% (380) are undertaken by workers who commute to Cootehill from outside the county.

**Profile of Locally based Jobs (Cootehill)** 








#### Age Profile of Workers





According to POWCAR 2016, there are 1,402 jobs based in Cootehill. This accounts for 6.8% of all jobs based in the county. Although 44% of the resident workers in Cootehill are employed elsewhere (see previous page), Cootehill is the employment destination for 937 workers from outside the settlement. The town is a net importer of jobs (+340).


