




Key Aims for the development of this plan

Do you think that these key aims as outlined above are appropriate?





Findings from the first public consultation

A preliminary public consultation was successfully held through February 2023, with valuable insights emerging that have now informed key ideas:

How **close** do you live to the park?




61% of respondants

More native plants, shrubs and trees

The ground is very wet and unsuitable for family picnics.

More resources for the weekly park run event would be really great.

More seating, and develop the river area for the ducks and the other animals

The park needs a dedicated park warden

Requires better lighting at night on paths

Draft Plan for Con Smith Park

A plan has been developed in response to the ideas and responses outlined across each of Boards 1 and 2; this begins to set out how the park could eventually be

Overview of the key Design Drivers:

A number of important drivers are outlined below, each of which relate to the emerging Masterplan:

Environmental improvements along the road boundaries present opportunities to create framed **points of access** and sustainable drainage systems (SuDS).

Enhancement of lands located north of Institute while in development abeyance: **ecological** enhancement, hedge buffer, casual **games/lawn** area, and seating.

Enhanced pedestrian **links** between Cavan Institute and parkland, creating a network of **campus routes** and nodes that connect to local **points of interest**.

Opportunity for **direct connections** to Cavan Institute while rationalising the parking configuration and quantities, including increased disabled parking.

Increased and centralised location for **parkland play**, with improved links to lawn picnic space, outdoor seating and an **accessible network** of pathways.

Woodland **trail route** to create an adventurous link through an enhanced **native woodland** - located centrally and linking to key areas of visitor interest.

Enhanced links over the protected and augmented **river corridor** offer ease of movement, with **interpretive** points presenting unique visitor moments.
