Introduction

The Road Traffic Act 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), with effect from 20 January 2005, provides the legislative basis for speed limits. The Act introduced metric values for speed limits and also provides for:

- the adoption of new Default Speed Limits for roads in built up areas, on motorways, rural national roads and rural regional and local roads.
- the application of Special Speed Limits through the making of Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws by the members of county and city councils.
- the broadening of consultation on proposed Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws by providing for consultation with the public.
- the issue of Guidelines by the Minister for Transport in respect of the making of Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws.

Changes in Cavan

This Draft incorporates into one document for the first time the Special speed Limit Bye-Laws for the whole of County Cavan.

Note that housing estates will be included in a separate schedule in the Bye-Laws for the first time. Housing estates built by the local authority or built privately and "Taken in Charge" by the local authority will have a speed limit of 30km/h. Theses estates are listed in Schedule Four of the Draft Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2017. Private housing estates that have not been declared a public road are not included in these Bye-Laws.

- A review of submissions from Municipal District Managers.

General Explanatory Notes:

The changes to the bye-laws document are highlighted with a dashed line and red text the existing shown in solid line and blue text in the Appendix 1 and 2 of the bye-laws maps.

The distance covered by each Special Speed Limit is outlined in their draft bye-laws from the centre line of the nearest road. The road is described by a road number.

A Built-up Area is defined by Section 2(1) of the Local Government Act 2001 as the area of a city, borough or town council within the meaning of the Act. For speed limits Section 5 of the Road Traffic Act 2004 sets a default speed limit of 50 km/h for 'built-up-areas'. The abolition of Town Councils in 2014 has not affected the meaning, definition and scope of these built-up areas, thus the default speed limit for all roads within these areas remains 50km/h. Special Speed Limits are required for speed limits other than 50 km/h in these areas.

The following summarises the situation:

- Default speed limits for former town council areas remain and this boundary will be referred to as the "the built-up area speed limit boundary". This applies to Cavan Town, Belturbet Town and Cootehill Town.
- Special Speed Limits are set on the same basis as outlined in these draft bye-laws

The layout of the speed limit bye-laws has also changed. The First Schedule refers to 80km/h Special Speed Limits, the Second Schedule refers to 50 km/h, the Third Schedule refers to 60 km/h and the fourth schedule refers to 30 km/h.

The proposed bye-laws are shown in the maps (appendix 1 and 2) for each town and village and national road network and are displayed with the following legend

- 30 kmph zone Green solid line (new speed limit being introduced)
- 50 kmph zone Red solid line (existing and will be included in 2017 bye laws)
- 50 kmph zone Red dashed (proposed change and proposed amendment to 2017 byelaws)
- 60 kmph zone –Blue solid line (existing and will be included in 2017 bye-laws)

- 60 kmph zone–Blue dashed Line (proposed change and proposed amendment to 2017 bye-laws)
- 60 kmph periodic –Blue dashed Line (proposed change and proposed amendment to 2017 bye-laws) - Aghadreenagh National School and St. Felim's National School (Leiter).
- 80 kmph zone Black dashed line (proposed change and proposed amendment to 2017 Bye Laws)
- 100 kmph zone Orange solid line (remaining as 100 km/hr default national road speed limit)

Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) (County of Cavan) Bye-Laws, <u>2017</u>

Cavan County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004) as amended by Section 86 of the Road Traffic Act 2010 and with the consent of Transport infrastructure Ireland (TII) in the case of National Roads and having given notice to the Commissioner of An Garda Síochána, hereby makes the following bye-laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative County of Cavan.

"Administrative County of Cavan means the County of Cavan.

"housing estate" for the purpose of these bye-laws are considered to be self-contained groupings of houses with single or multiple entry points for vehicles or local residential roads that do not serve as through roads with in the local road network. Such areas often have green areas or play areas associated with them;

"maps" means the accompanying maps (appendix 1 & 2) for each town or village and the national road network as detailed in Schedule 1;

"**special speed limit**" as defined in Section 9 of the Act of 2004 shall be the speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on the roads specified in the schedule to these bye-laws.

Special Speed Limit

4(a) Each of the roads specified in Part One and Part Two of the First Schedule to these Bye-Laws is hereby declared to have a special speed limit of 80 kmph for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act 2004.

- Each of the roads specified in the Second Schedule to these Bye-laws is hereby declared to have a special speed limit of 50 kmph for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.
- Each of the roads specified in the Third Schedule to these Bye-laws is hereby declared to have a special speed limit of 60 kmph for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.
- 7. Each of the roads specified in the Fourth Schedule to these Bye-Laws is hereby declared to have a special speed limit of 30 kmph for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

The maps incorporated herewith at **Appendix 1 & 2** shall be deemed to form part of and be read in conjunction with these Bye-Laws.

There shall be exempted from the special limits prescribed at 9 above the following:-

- i. ambulance (as defined by Section 87 of the Act of 2014),
- ii. fire brigade vehicles (as defined by Section 87 of the Act of 2014),
- iii. vehicles used by members of the GardaSíochána in the performance of theirduties as such members,
- any vehicle subject to a speed limit as prescribed by the Minister pursuant to Section 4 of the Road Traffic Act 2004.

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Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the Bye-Laws and does not purport to be a legal interpretation

Under the Road Traffic Act 2004 there are four speed limits that apply on a default basis:

- The "Motorway Speed Limit" of 120 kmph
- The "National Roads Speed Limit" of 100 kmph
- The "Regional and Local Roads Speed Limit" of 80 kmph and
- The "built-up area speed limit" of 50 kmph
- "housing estate" for the purpose of these Bye-Laws are considered to be selfcontained groupings of houses with single or multiple entry points for vehicles or local residential roads that do not serve as through roads with in the local road network. Such areas often have green areas or play areas associated with them.

If the default limit is not appropriate for a particular location, a special speed limit can be created. Special speed limits are speed limits that are specified in bye-laws made by elected members of county and city councils:

In relation to built-up area:

There is a speed limit ("built-up area speed limit") of 50 kmph in respect of all public roads, other than a motorway in built-up area for all mechanically propelled vehicles.

"built up area" means the area of a city, a borough or a town within the meaning of the Local Government Act 2001.

In the case of Cavan, Cootehill and Belturbet this means that all public roads within the Town Boundaries automatically have a default "built up area speed limit" of 50 kmph.

FIRST SCHEDULE

National Roads in the County of Cavan declared to have a special speed limit of 80 kmph for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004. The 80 kmph speed limit locations are as follows:

(a) Part One

National Road N3

<u>N3 Edenburt (Cavan / Meath County Boundary) to Cavan / Fermanagh County</u> <u>Boundary</u>

- 1. The following section of road between Cavan and Virginia:
 - A. The Cavan Road (N3) from a point 212 metres south east of its junction with the L7031 and L7032 (Murmod's Cross), to a point 1,100 metres north of the said junction at Cornaslieve.
- 2. The following section of road between Virginia and Maghera:
 - B. The Dublin Road (N3) from a point 822 metres south east of its junction with the Bailieborough Road (R-178) (36 metres south east of Mullagh road (R194)) to a point 119 metres north west of its junction with the Munterconnaught Road (L3024).

National Road N54

N54 Leggykelly (Cavan / Fermanagh County Boundary) to Butlers Bridge

- 3. The following section of road between Butlers Bridge and Cloverhill:
 - A. The N54 from a point 527 metres north of the N54 Butlers Bridge roundabout to a point 97m north of its junction with the L5550 at Plush.

National Road N55

N55 Cavan to Cavan / Longford County Boundary

- 1. The following section of road between Ballytrust Lower and Killydoon:
 - A. The Cavan-Granard Road (N55) from a point 204 metres south of its junction with the L6591 at Ballytrust Lower, to a point 201 metres north-west of its junction with the L2515 at Killydoon.
- 2. The following section of road between Killydoon and Ballinagh:

A. The Cavan-Granard Road (N55) from a point 365 metres south east of its junction with the Middleton road (L2515) to a point 1,038 metres from the said junction.

<u>N87 Belturbet to Swanlinbar to the (Cavan / Fermanagh County Boundary)</u>

- 1. The following section of road between Belturbet and Ballyconnell:
 - A. The Belturbet-Swanlinbar Road (N87) from a point 13 metres west of its junction with the L5518 at Lisnamaine or Sycamore Fields, to a point 212 metres south of its junction with the Aghalane Road L1505.
- 2. The following section of road at Ballyconnell:
 - A. The Belturbet-Swanlinbar Road (N87) from a point 405 metres north west of its junction with Main Street(R-205) junction. to a point 1,109 metres from said junction.
- 3. The following section of road between Bawnboy and Swanlinbar:
 - A. The Belturbet-Swanlinbar Road (N87) from a point 443 metres north-west of its junction with the Ballinamore Road L1037 at Bawnboy, to a point 178 metres south of its junction with the Derrylin Road L1031.
- 4. The following section of road between Swanlinbar and Cavan / Fermanagh County Boundary:
 - A. The Belturbet-Swanlinbar Road (N87) from a point 666 metres north-west of its junction with the Derrylin Road L1031 at Hawkswood, to the Cavan / Fermanagh County Boundary.

(b) Part Two

Non-National Roads in County Cavan within the Town boundary of Belturbet Town Council declared to have a special speed limit of 80 km's per hour for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

- a) The Straheglin Road (L5527) for a distance of 88 metres north of the Town Council boundary in the direction of Belturbet.
- b) The L55391 from its junction with Creeny to Quivvy Road (L5539) to the Town Council boundary
- c) The Buttermilk Bridge Road, (L5516) from the Cavan road R197 for a distance of 55 metres north west to the Town Council boundary.
- d) The Noghan Road or Derryvona Road (L5515) from a point 361 metres northeast of its junction with Kilconny Street (L5516) to the Town Council boundary.

- e) The Noghan Lane (L55151) from its junction with the Noghan Road to the Town Council boundary.
- f) The Noghan/Cornadarragh Road, (L55152), from its junction with the Noghan Road to the Town Council boundary.
- g) The Creeney Road (L1501) from a point 370 metres east of the junction with the Creeny-Quivvy Road (L5539) to the town Council Boundary.
- h) The Creeny-Quivvy Road, (L5539), from its junction with the Creeny Road north to the Town Council boundary.
- i) The R197 at Sugar Road for a distance of 44 metres north of the R197/L1535 junction to the Town Council boundary.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Roads in the County of Cavan declared to have a special speed limit of 50 kmph for the purposes of Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004. All roads in the urban area in the charge of the council within the 50 kmph zone will have a default limit of 50kmph. The 50 kmph speed limit locations are as follows:

The following roads in Arvagh:

- a) Broad Street (L6637), Longford Street (L6535), Pound Street(R198),
- b) The Carrigallen-Arva-Cavan Road (R203) from a point 392 metres east of its junction with the Gowna road L2507 to its junction with Pound Street.

- f) The Drumalt Road, (L6542) for a distance of 86 metres from its junction with the Cavan-Carrigallen Road (R198).
- g) The Carrigallen to Cavan Road (R203) for a distance of 794 metres north west of its junction with Pound Street (R198).

The following roads at Bailieborough

- a) Church Street (R165), Henry Street (L7616), Main Street (R165), Market Square and New Road (L7618).
- b) William Street (L3553) and its continuation as the L3553 road from its junction with Main Street (R165) to its junction with the L3540/L7584 road junction.
- c) The L76151 road and L76152 road to a point 25 metres North East of the Cavan road Junction (R165)
- d) Adelaide Row and its continuation as the Shercock Road (R178) for a distance of 985 metres from its junction with Main Street (R165).
- e) The Cavan Road (R165) for a distance of 733 metres from its junction with New Road/Church Street.
- f) The Galbolie Road (L3540) for a distance of 707 meters from its junction with

the L7584 road.

- g) The Bailieborough Relief Road from its roundabout with the Shercock Road (R178) and its roundabout with the Kingscourt Road (R165).
- h) The Virginia Road R178 for a distance of 948 metres south west of its junction with Barrack Street (R178) and Main Street (R165).
- i) The Kells Road (R191) for a distance of 326 metres from its junction with the Virginia Road (R178).
- j) The Kingscourt Road (R165) for a distance of 1,017 metres from the junction of Thomas Street (R165) with Main Street (R165).
- k) The L7584 road from its junction with the Galbolie Road (L3540) for a distance of 340 metres south west of said junction.
- 1) The Pottle Lower Road (L75661) for a distance of 563 metres north from its junction with the L7566 road.
- m) The Corkish-Corraghy Rd (L3528) for a distance of 53 metres south east from its junction with the Kingscourt Road(R165).
- n) The old landfill site Road (L7586) for a distance of 25 metres from its junction with the Virginia Road (R178).
- o) The Institute Road (L3529) for a distance of 410 metres from the Market Square.
- p) The L7566 for a distance of 676 metres east from its junction with the Kingscourt Road R165.
- q) The L7569 Road from its junction with the R165 Kingscourt Road to its junction with the Institute Road (L3529).

The following roads at Ballinagh:

- a) The Cavan-Athlone road (N55) between a point 535 metres north-east of its junction with the Crossdoney Road (R154) and a point 441 metres south of its junction with the Crossdoney/Kilnaleck Road (R154).
- b) The Kilnaleck Road (R154) for a distance of 266 metres south east from its junction with the Cavan to Athlone road (N55).
- c) The Crossdoney Road (R154) for a distance of 350 metres from Main Street junction (R154) with the Cavan to Athlone Road (N55).
- d) The Arvagh Road (L2503) for a distance of 55 metres west from its junction

with the Cavan to Athlone Road (N55).

e) The Garrymore Road (L6520) a distance 41 metres west from its junction with the Cavan to Athlone Road (N55).

The following roads at Ballyconnell:

- a) The Preaching House Lane (L50532) for a distance of 416 metres from its junction with Main Street (R205).
- b) The Belturbet to Ballyconnell Road (N87) for a distance of 539 metres south east of its junction with Main Street (R205).
- c) The Swanlinbar to Ballyconnell Road (N-87) for a distance of 405 metres north west of its junction with Main Street(R-205) junction.
- d) The Chapel Road L1044 and its continuation as the Killeshandra Road (L1045) for a distance of 127 metres from its junction with the (L-1043).
- e) The L1043 road between its junction with the Belturbet to Ballyconnell Road N87 and its junction with the L1044/L1045.
- f) The Ballinamore Road (R205) for a distance of 401 metres from its junction with the Belturbet to Ballyconnell road (N87).
- g) Main Street (R205) and its continuation as the Derrylin Road (R205) for a distance of 406 meters from the Mucklagh Lane (L50531)
- h) The Derryginny road (L5049) for a distance of 30 metres from its junction with the Belturbet to Swanlinbar Road (N87).
- i) The Mucklagh Lane (L50531) for a distance of 343 metres north-east from its junction with the Derrylin Road (R205).
- j) The Aghalane Road (the Yellow Road) (L1505) for a distance of 696 metres from its junction with the Belturbet to Ballyconnell Road (N87).

The following roads at Ballyhaise:

- a) The Square(R212),
- b) Oakwood (Reservoir) Lane (L20021) for a distance of 433 metres from its junction with the Cavan to Clones Road (R212).
- c) The Cavan to Clones (R212) road between a point 1,234 metres south-west of its junction with the Bog Road (L5552) and a point 919 metres north-east of the said junction.

- d) The Bog Road (L5552), Annaghduff Road for a distance of 371 metres from its junction with The Square (R212).
- e) The Butlers Bridge road (L5553) for a distance of 334 metres west of its junction with the Cavan to Clones Road (R212).
- f) The Antiduff to Crossforts road (L6030) for a distance of 556 metres from its junction with the Cavan-Clones Road (R212).
- g) The Ouley Road (L6028) for a distance of 96 metres south-east from its junction with the Cavan to Clones Road (R212).
- h) The Raheg Road (L6027) for a distance of 290 metres south-east from its junction with the Cavan to Clones Road(R212).
- i) The Cootehill Road (L2010) for a distance of 56 metres east from its junction with the Cavan to Clones (R212).

The following roads at Ballyiamesduff:

- a) Market Street (L3031), Anne Street (R194)
- b) Dublin Street (L3029) from its junction with the Virginia Road (R194) and its continuation on the Cavan Road (L3029) for a distance of 706 metres from Virginia Road (R194) junction.
- c) The Virginia Road (R194) for a distance of 1,409 metres from its junction with Dublin Street (L3029).
- d) Chapel Street (L3013) and its continuation as the Oldcastle Road (L3013) for a distance of 376 metres from the junction of Chapel Street (L3013) and Granard Street (R194).
- e) Granard Street (R194) and its continuation as the Granard Road(R194) for a distance of 598 metres from the junction of Granard Street (R194) with Chapel Street (L3013).
- f) The Ramonan Road (L7132) for a distance of 252 metres from its junction with the Granard Road (R194).
