Dan is a busy 14-year-old cowboy, innocent Dolores and wily Cactus' hormones are raging, while Ber is hoping you can't get pregnant if you were standing up...

By the end of the summer, their lives will have changed forever. Gina Moxley's Danti-Dan is the shamelessly funny tale of the sexual-awakening of five innocent youngsters in a dead-end small town. Bursting with hormones in bloom, sentimental nostalgia and brash young cynicism, it is a hilarious exploration of puberty blues, and a sensitive, sharp-shock teenage comedy with tragic undertones. Danti-Dan is one of the greatest Irish plays of the past few decades. It is a theatrical gem.






A virtuoso keyboard player, he really shines at all the great ABBA keyboard parts.
