
MAP 7 : Landscape Character Areas



1. Cuilcagh-Anierin Uplands of West Cavan

This is the mountaineous region of north-west Cavan, stretching from Blacklion and Dowra to Belturbet.

2. The Lakelands

This is primarily composed of the Lough Oughter lake system stretching from Belturbet to Lough Gowna.

3. Lake Catchments of South Cavan

This area takes in the larger lakes of Lough Sheelin and Lough Ramor and their catchment areas in south Cavan.

4. Drumlin Belt and Uplands of East Cavan

While much of Cavan is dominated by drumlins, this area is described as the central area of the County, stretching north-east from Shercock to south-west and Kilcogy.

5. Highlands of East Cavan

The area comprises Kingscourt and the Bailieborough area.
