1. Subsequent to the recent Traffic Survey carried out in Bailieborough, I wish to ask if a new traffic plan for Bailieborough Town has been developed yet, and what is the expected timeline for implementation of this plan.
2. To ask if the MD have considered developing an interim solution to traffic congestion and lack of public parking currently on Main Street Bailieborough, which is mainly due to two very welcome but large construction projects on the Main Street, and associated Trades engaged at these sites, who are using the majority of Parking on Main Street, with their construction vehicles, vans, and their deliveries, and also normal deliveries to the Town Business's. The situation is very dangerous at present for Pedestrians throughout the town but particularly so at the Thomas Street/Main Street Junction, and the Adelaide Road/Main street Junction.
3. To ask MD to write to TFI (Transport for Ireland) to ask if they would consider installing designated "Official Bus Stops" on the Bailieborough / Cavan Road. Regular users of 170 Bus Services have contacted me and have said some Bus Drivers do not stop to do pickups, along this route, and consequently they have missed Hospital Appointments in Cavan as the Bus has driven past them. If one or two designated "Bus Stops" were in place which People could wait at, this situation could be avoided.
